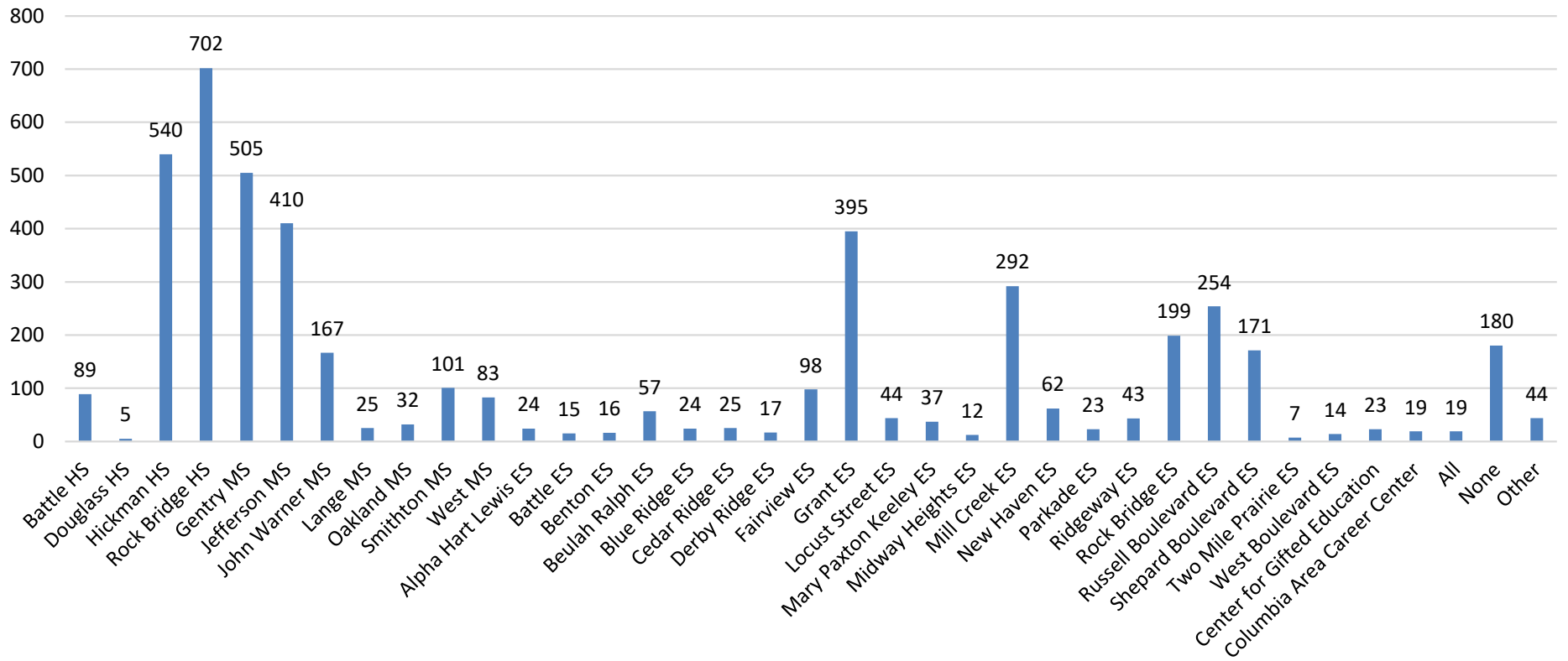

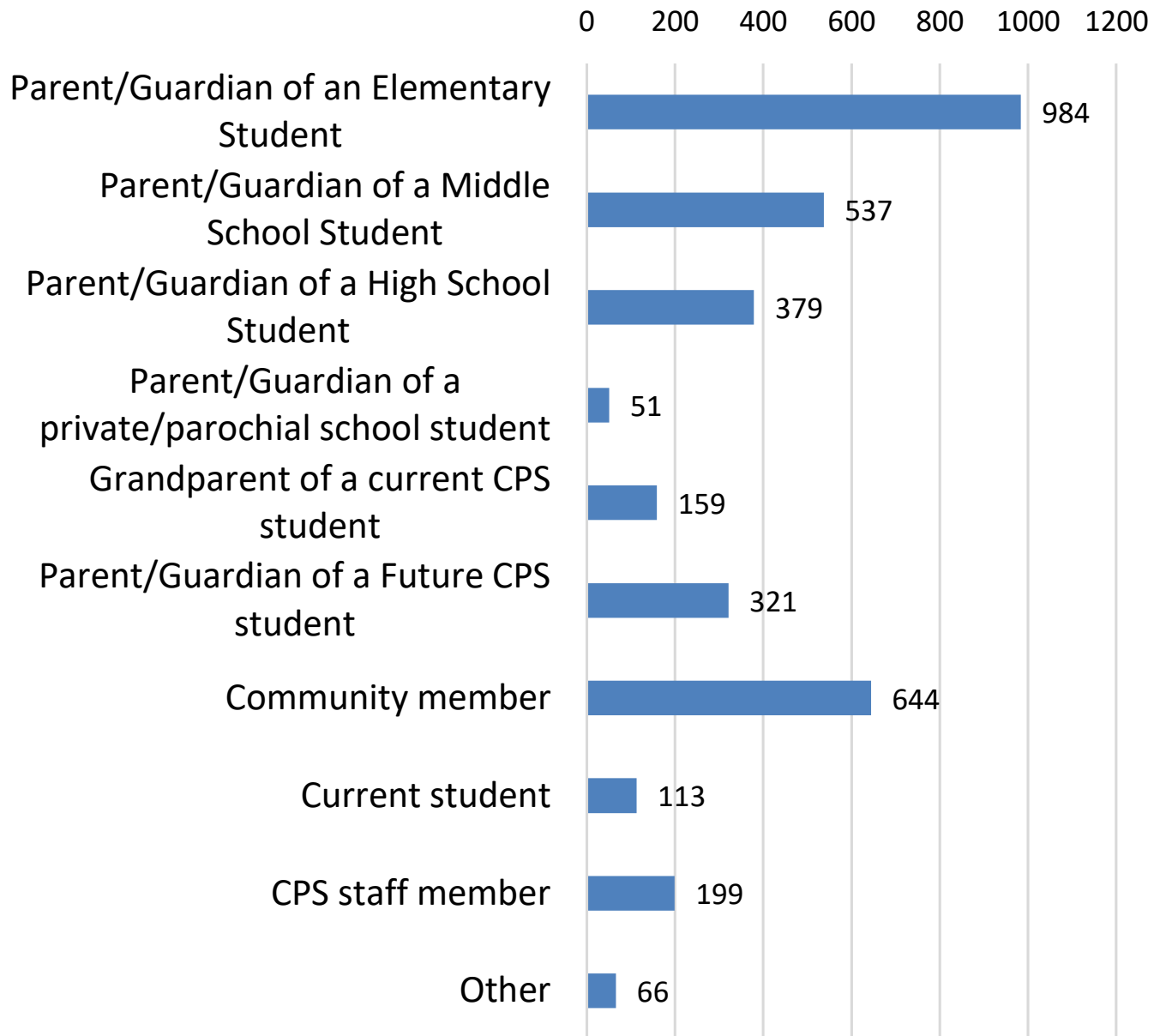

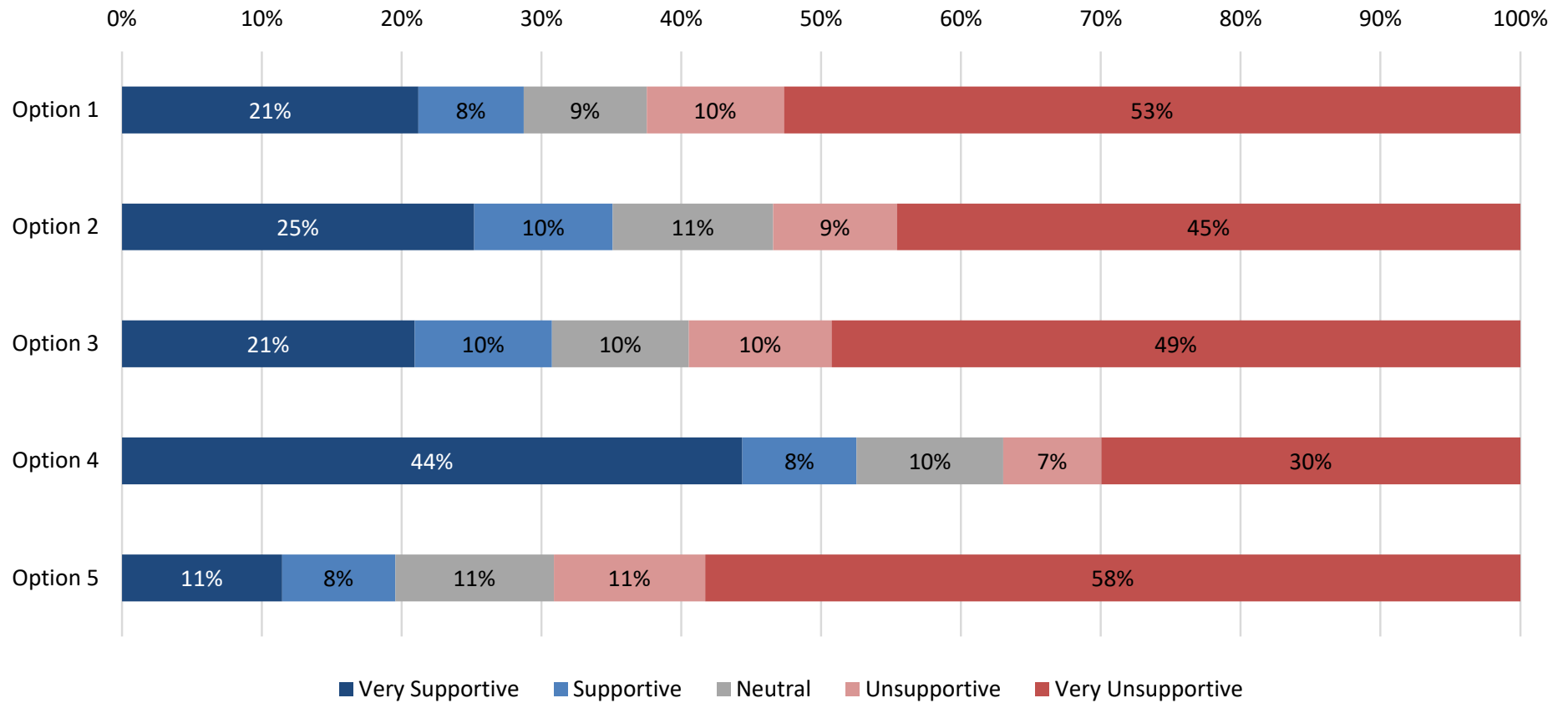


Parent/Guardian/Student Status

Comment Summary

Option 1

- Dislikes the longer commute to Battle High School when other high schools are closer.
- Worries about transportation, specifically new drivers on the highway.
- Previous redistricting impacts have left families feeling weary about a new change for students.

Option 2

- Worries about the mental health risks and stability of the children because the targeted neighborhoods just experienced redistricting 2 years ago.
- Concern about new driver's safety.
- Desire to keep children who receive special services at their current schools.
- Desires to maintain walkability.

Option 3

- Desire to attend schools in closer proximity.
- Questions the feasibility of transportation while bussing delays are currently happening.
- Hopes to have 5th graders, 8th graders, and seniors grandfathered -in to their school before the redistricting takes effect.
- Worries about the safety of students attending new schools.
- Notes that diversity is not evenly spread throughout the district.

Option 4

- Supports the walkability of schools, specifically elementary schools.
- Likes that fewer students are moved.
- Requests Sawgrass Dr., Valhalla, Annandale, and Hazeltine Ct. remain in the MCE district.
- Desires the change to happen at the elementary school level, not the middle and high school levels.

Option 5

- Specific neighborhoods request to remain in their current boundaries (Shephard).
- Worries about transportation, specifically new drivers on the highway.
- Notes that diversity is not evenly spread throughout the district.
