## **Call to Order**

The meeting was called to order by President King at 7:30 a.m.

#### **Consideration of Agenda**

The first matter of business was consideration of approval of the agenda for the August 22, 2013, meeting of the Board of Education. It was moved by Ms. Mees that the agenda be approved as presented. The second was by Mr. Sessions. The vote was 6 yes—0 no—1 absent.

# Tax Rate Hearing and Consideration of School District Tax Levy

Dr. Belcher and Ms. Quinley presented an overview of the process used to determine the proposed tax rate for the Columbia School District for the 2013-14 school year. It was recommended that the tax rate for 2013-14 be established as follows:

Incidental Fund	. 2.7500
Teachers Fund	\$1.6413
Capital Projects Fund	.1007
Total Operating Funds Levy	\$4.4920
Debt Service Fund Levy	.9319
Total Levy	\$5.4239

President King invited public comments on the proposed tax rate. No comments were received.

After discussion, it was moved by Dr. Rose that the 2013-14 tax rate be established at \$5.4239 as recommended. The second was by Ms. Mees. The vote was 7 yes—0 no.

## **Board of Education Resolution Regarding HB253**

Ms. Mees, who serves on the board of the Missouri School Boards Association (MSBA), led a discussion regarding a sample resolution provided by MSBA urging the General Assembly to sustain Governor Jay Nixon's recent veto of House Bill 253. A variety of school districts across Missouri are supporting this resolution. After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Preis that the Columbia Board of Education support this resolution. The second was by Mr. Sessions. The vote was 7 yes—0 no.

It was moved by Mr. Preis that the Board of Education immediately adjourn to meet in executive session at the Administration Building, 1818 West Worley Street, for the purpose of considering issues related to the leasing, sale, or purchase of real estate as authorized by the provisions of Section 610.021(2) of the Missouri statutes.
