Consideration of Agenda

Tax Rate Hearing and Consideration of School District Tax Levy

Dr. Belcher and Ms. Quinley presented an overview of the process used to determine the proposed tax rate for the Columbia School District for the 2011-12 school year. It was recommended that the tax rate for 2011-12 be established as follows:

Levy for Operating Purposes	\$4.0793
Debt Service Fund	.8019
Total Levy	\$4.8812

President Rose invited public comments on the proposed tax rate. No comments were received.

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Whitt that the 2011-12 tax rate be established at \$4.8812 as recommended. The second was by Mr. Sessions. After further discussion, the vote on the motion was 6 yes—0 no—1 absent.
