Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by President King at 7:30 a.m.

Consideration of Agenda

The first matter of business was consideration of approval of the agenda for the October 24, 2013, meeting of the Board of Education. It was moved by Mr. Preis that the agenda be approved as presented. The second was by Dr. Rose. The vote was 7 yes—0 no.

Northeast Elementary Boundary Change Process Update

Dr. Peter Stiepleman presented an update on the process to be used for determining attendance area boundaries for the new elementary school to be constructed north of Battle High School. A committee will be formed to consider attendance area boundaries and transition plans that will consider reducing overcrowding, reducing bus ride time, reflecting the composition of the community, and allowing for growth at all sites. Dr. Stiepleman expects the committee to have a recommendation to present to the Board of Education for consideration of approval by April 2014.

Bond Project Update

Chris Davis of PWArchitects, Inc., provided an update on 2012 bond projects. He also presented a list of future district building projects and the expected timeline for each project's design, submission to the city for permit, bid start, bid opening, Board of Education approval, and the start of construction.
